

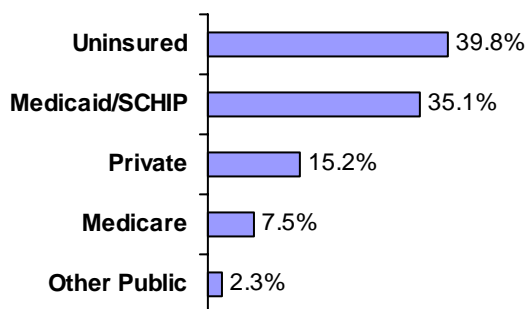


BASIC FACTS & FIGURES:

NONPROFIT COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS¹

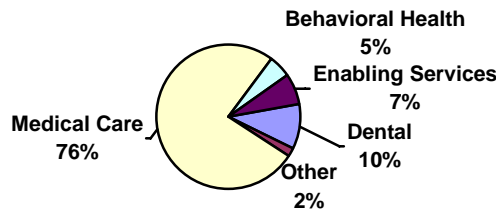
- Community Health Centers, also known as Federally-Qualified Health Centers, are local, non-profit, community-owned health care providers that serve low-income and medically underserved communities. There are over 1,002 Community Health Centers delivering care through over 6,000 service delivery sites in every state and territory.
- Community Health Centers are located in high-need areas (e.g., elevated poverty, above average infant mortality, few physicians); are open to all residents, regardless of insurance status or ability to pay; and are cost effective, reducing costly emergency, hospital, and specialty care, and saving the U.S. health care system between \$9.9 to \$17.6 billion a year.
- Community Health Centers served 15,034,123 total patients in 2006. Since 2000, the number of patients and patient visits has grown 56% and 55%, respectively. Patients tend to be low-income, a racial or ethnic minority, uninsured or publicly insured (e.g., Medicaid), from rural areas, and chronically ill (compared to patients of office-based physicians).

- Community Health Centers aim to provide high-quality, affordable primary care and preventive services in a linguistically and culturally appropriate manner. Dental, pharmaceutical, mental health, substance abuse, and enabling services (i.e., case manager and health educator visits) are often provided on-site as well.
- Community Health Centers' average cost per patient is \$538 (\$368 medical; \$333 dental). The average cost per medical patient visit is \$117. In 2006, annual federal funding per uninsured patient was only \$267.
