



BASIC FACTS & FIGURES:

NONPROFIT HEALTH PLANS¹

- Of the 138 health plans in the United States with at least 100,000 enrollees, 84 or 61% are nonprofit.
- Of the 199,049,963 total enrollees of these 142 health plans, 93,778,581 or 47% are in nonprofit health plans.
- It is estimated that nonprofit Blue Cross Blue Shield plans have about 34% of the commercial risk market and 32% of the commercial administrative services-only (ASO) market and that other nonprofit health plans have about 20% of the commercial risk market and 10% of the commercial ASO market, with for-profit plans accounting for the remaining percentages of these two markets.²
